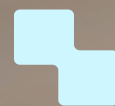

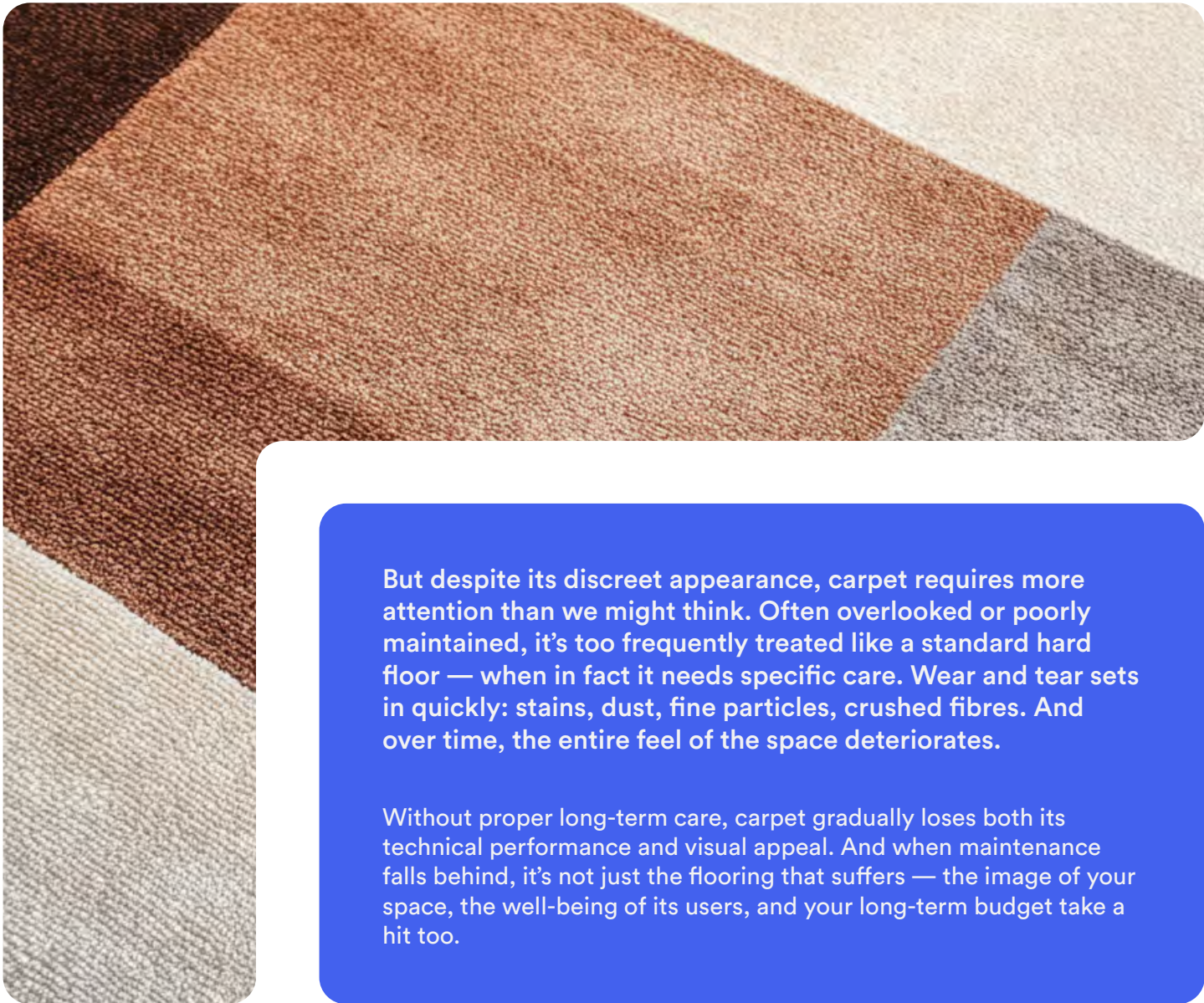

Carpet – the essential choice for professional spaces

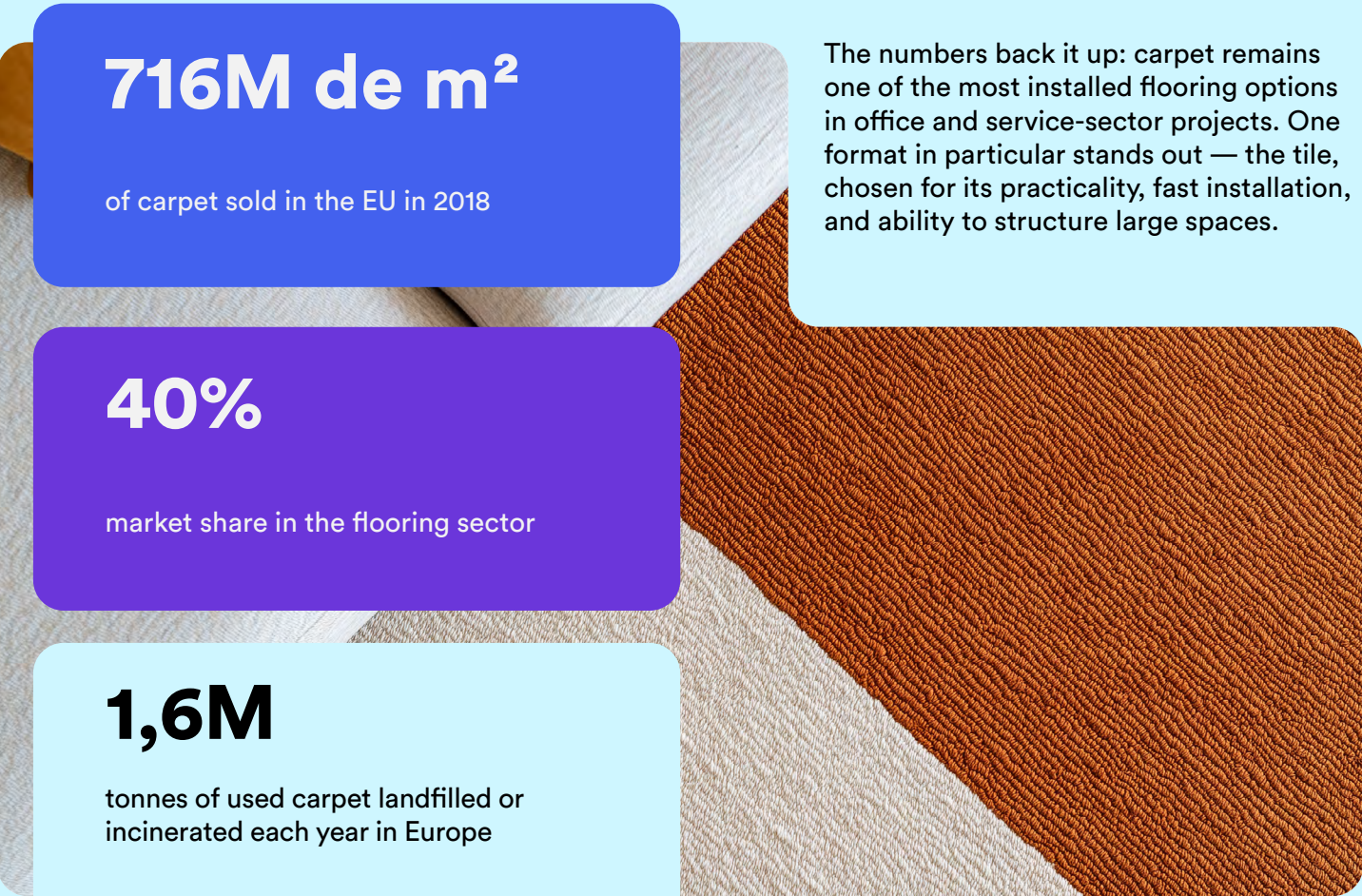
Market snapshot

A well-established presence

Every year, hundreds of millions of square metres of carpet are installed in commercial buildings across Europe. It's not a passing trend or a second-rate option — it's a de facto standard in interior design.

It doesn't get much attention, but carpet is everywhere — in public tenders, renovation projects, turnkey spaces. It covers vast surfaces, often without being noticed. Yet in the flooring market, carpet plays a central role — **and it's still gaining ground.**

Every year, massive volumes of carpet are installed in commercial spaces — driven by the fast pace of interior fit-outs and the demand for modular solutions.



But this market growth comes with a major challenge: end-of-life management.

Every year, enormous amounts of used carpet are removed from buildings — **yet less than 3% are actually recycled in Europe.** Most are incinerated or landfilled due to the **lack of appropriate recycling infrastructure.**

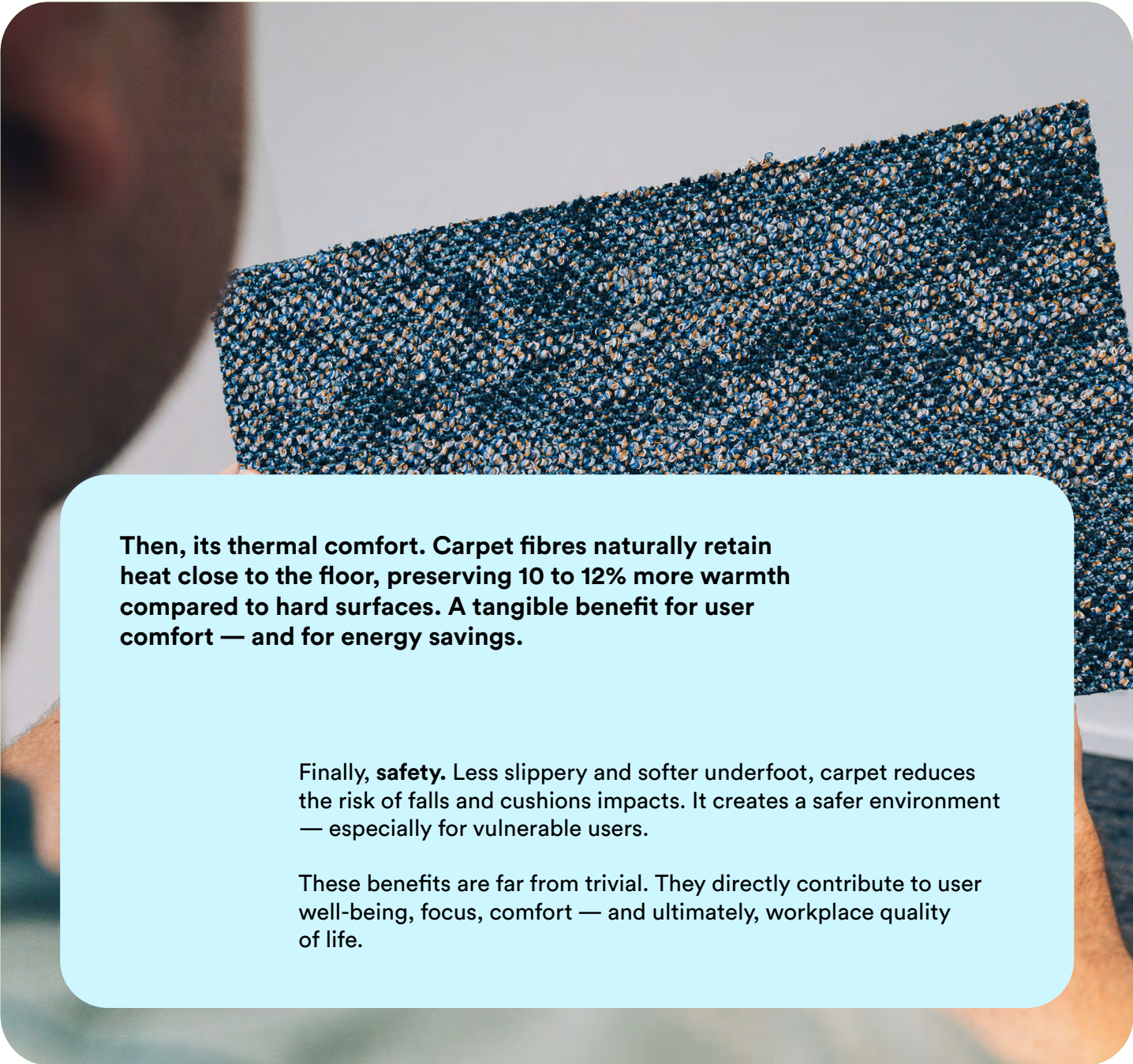
But the tide is turning: take-back schemes, recycled materials, reconditioning... the industry is shifting toward more circular models.

No-compromise performance

Silence, warmth, safety

In professional spaces, every detail matters. A well-chosen — and well-maintained — carpet can turn a functional place into a truly pleasant environment to work in.

First, through its **acoustic insulation**. By absorbing ambient noise, carpet improves focus, reduces stress, and softens daily tensions. A proven benefit: it would take 60 cm of hard flooring to match the sound absorption of textile carpet.



Then, its thermal comfort. Carpet fibres naturally retain heat close to the floor, preserving 10 to 12% more warmth compared to hard surfaces. A tangible benefit for user comfort — and for energy savings.

Finally, **safety**. Less slippery and softer underfoot, carpet reduces the risk of falls and cushions impacts. It creates a safer environment — especially for vulnerable users.

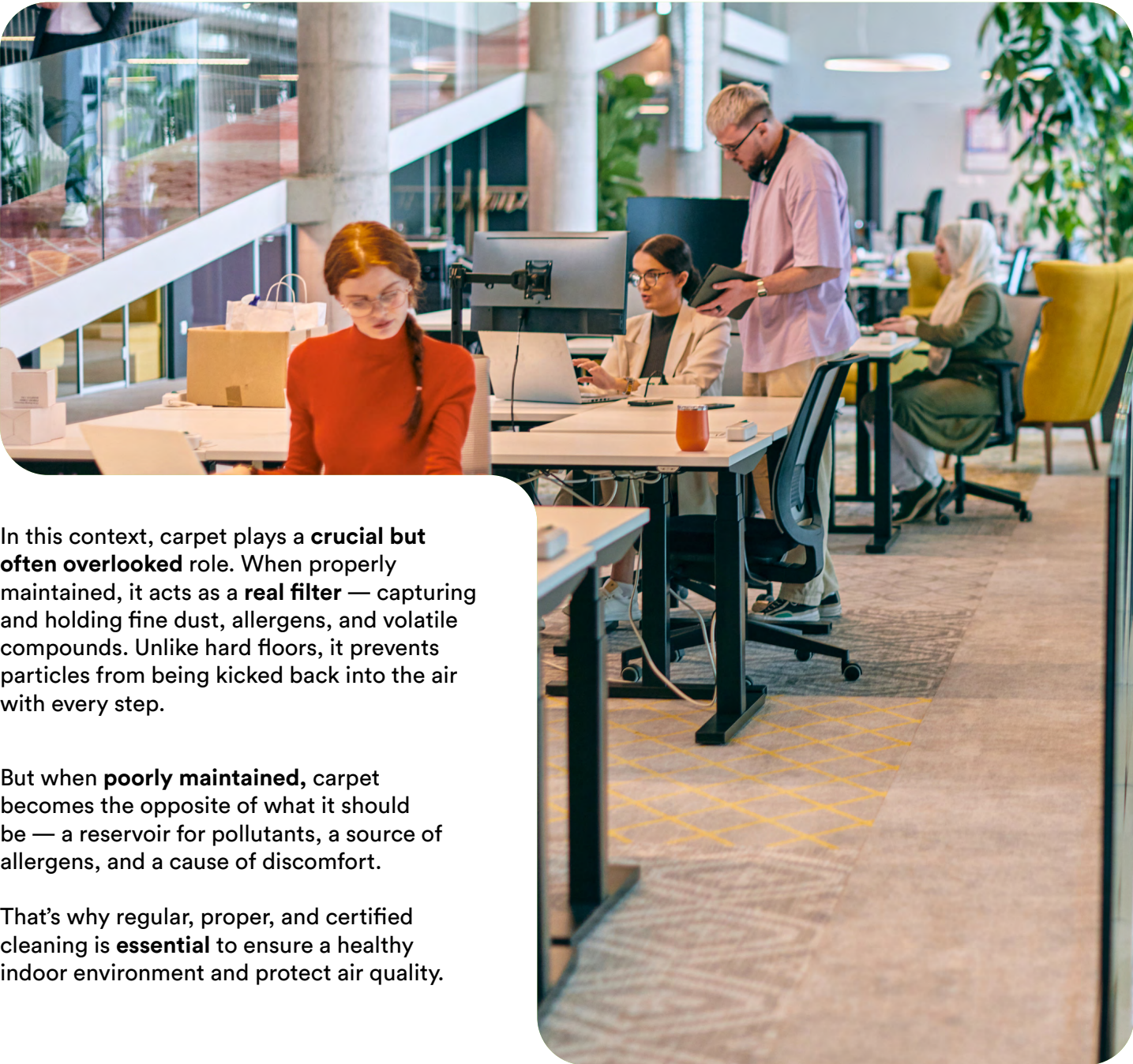
These benefits are far from trivial. They directly contribute to user well-being, focus, comfort — and ultimately, workplace quality of life.

A cleaner floor, a healthier space

Hygiene, health, air quality

Indoor air can be polluted — but a well-maintained carpet can make all the difference.

We often forget it, but we spend nearly **80% of our time indoors**. And yet, **indoor air is often 2 to 5 times more polluted than outdoor air**, according to numerous scientific studies. Materials, furniture, poor ventilation — all invisible, but real sources of pollution.



In this context, carpet plays a **crucial but often overlooked** role. When properly maintained, it acts as a **real filter** — capturing and holding fine dust, allergens, and volatile compounds. Unlike hard floors, it prevents particles from being kicked back into the air with every step.

But when **poorly maintained**, carpet becomes the opposite of what it should be — a reservoir for pollutants, a source of allergens, and a cause of discomfort.

That's why regular, proper, and certified cleaning is **essential** to ensure a healthy indoor environment and protect air quality.

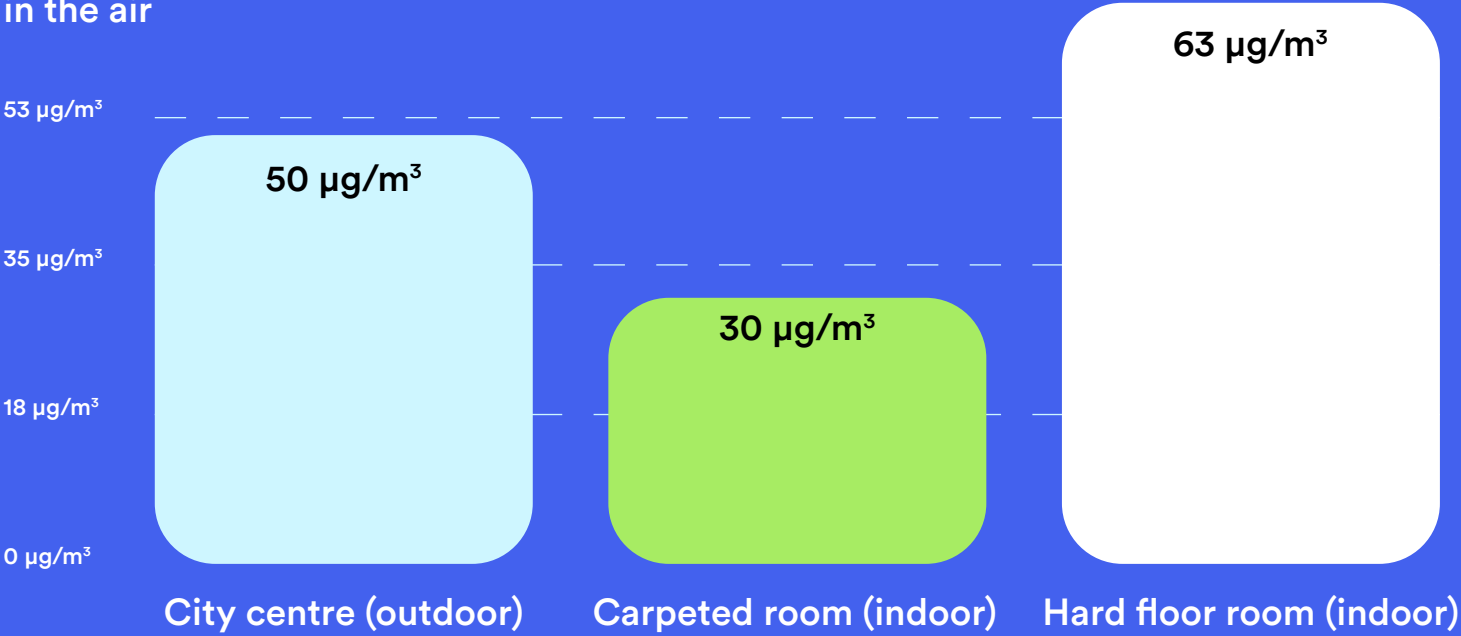
What the facts say

Data & studies

For years, carpet has carried a persistent reputation. It's been accused of trapping dust, triggering allergies, being less hygienic than other floors. It's true that it captures airborne particles — but that's precisely its strength. Acting like a filter, it prevents fine dust from re-circulating in the air. That is, if it's properly maintained.

The facts are clear: well-maintained carpet contributes to healthier indoor environments — and science backs it up.

Fine particle concentration in the air



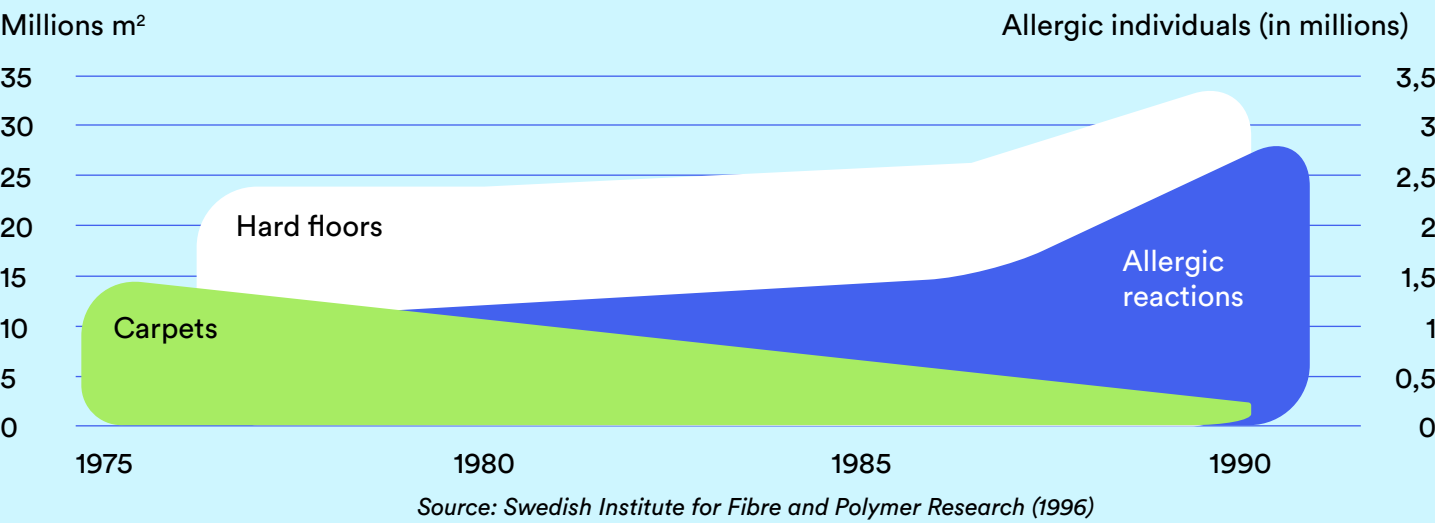

Allergy trends vs. carpet coverage

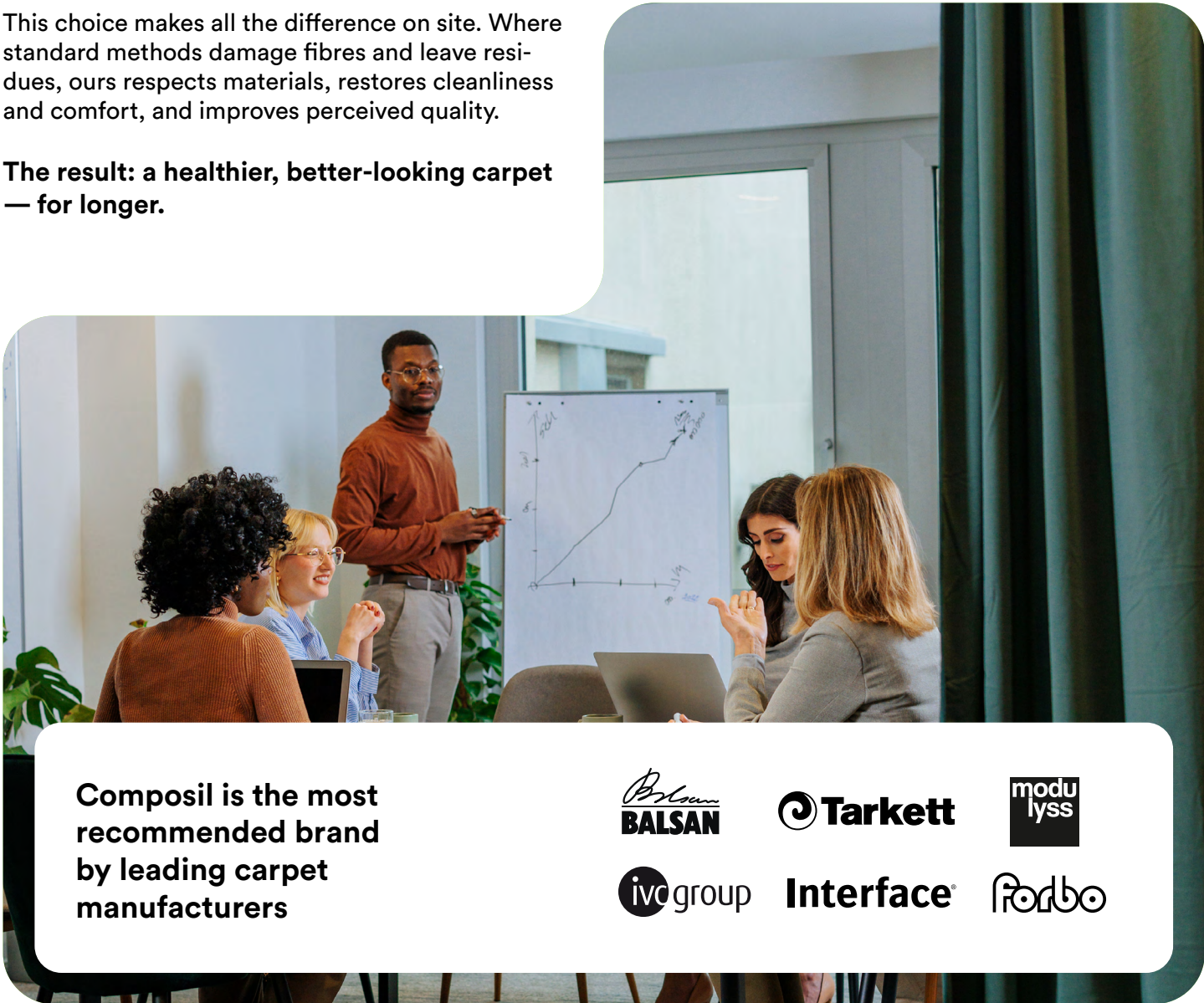
